II. Eligibility of Applicants

- Candidates who meet the basic requirement of having completed the first cycle of relevant or related studies, and who meet other requirements of study programs for second cycle of studies at the respective faculty, or scientific institute may enroll.
- Candidates who have completed the first cycle of relevant studies, and who meet other requirements of the study program in Architecture (second cycle of studies undergraduate studies) may enroll in the **second cycle of studies at the Faculty of Architecture**.
- For enrollment in Conference Interpreting studies at the Blaže Koneski Faculty of Philology, candidates are required to attend an admission interview.

Upon expiry of the deadline for applying, the candidates will be invited for an interview. A positive result from the interview is required for enrollment.

An invitation will be sent to candidates who meet the requirements for enrollment as per the study program, and who have submitted the complete documentation.

- III. Required Documents for Application and Enrollment

Prior to applying within the deadlines specified in the Competition, each candidate should register at www.upisi.ukim.mk and fill out the electronic application in the iKnow system.

The candidate's number that the e-application system automatically generated should also be included in the enrollment application. Applications shall be filed with the Student Inquiry Service of the respective faculty.

When applying for enrollment, candidates submit the following documents:

Applicants will receive an automatic confirmation for that the e-mail has been received and that the application has been duly submitted.

The units will publish on their bulletin boards the deadlines within which the candidates have to submit the original documents for application and enrollment.
