II. Enrollment Conditions and Criteria

- Candidates who have passed the state high school graduation exam, international baccalaureate or state vocational high school graduation exam have the right to enroll in the first cycle of academic studies, academic studies in the field of arts, and the first cycle of vocational studies.
In the academic year 2026/2027, candidates who have obtained a four-year secondary education diploma in the academic year 2019/2020 are also eligible to enroll in the first cycle of academic and professional studies, as well as in academic studies in the field of arts, in accordance with the Decree Having the Force of Law for the Application of the Law on Higher Education During a State of Emergency.
Candidates who have completed a four-year secondary education under the regulations that were in force before the introduction of the State Matura (before the academic year 2007/2008) also have the right to enroll in first cycle studies.

- Candidates enroll as full-time students funded by the state and full-time students with co-financing of their studies.
Part-time students may also enroll in the first cycle of studies at the faculties, provided that the nature of the study program allows it.

- Candidates who have completed higher or higher education at related faculties and colleges may also enroll in the first cycle of studies at the faculties. These candidates enroll outside the quota, up to a maximum of **10%** of the total number of full-time students at the respective faculty determined in this Call for Applications.
The ranking of candidates from the preceding paragraph shall be based on their grade point average from the previously completed higher or post-secondary education, except for study programs where, due to their specific nature, an assessment of knowledge and skills is required. The relatedness of the programs is determined and published by the faculties.

Candidates under this point enroll with co-financing of their studies, as do the candidates from Chapter V of this Call for Applications.

- The method of selection of candidates shall be carried out depending on the type of study programs for which they are applying, as follows:
 - Study programs where the selection of candidates will be based on the grade point average from secondary education;
 - Study programs where the selection will be based on the grade point average from secondary education and an assessment of the knowledge and skills of the candidates. This applies to study programs with specific characteristics.
- The basic criterion for the selection of candidates for enrollment in first cycle studies is the grade point average achieved in secondary education. The evaluation of the candidates' success is expressed in points.
 - For study programs where selection is based solely on the grade point average from secondary education, candidates may earn a maximum of **100 points**, as follows: **the overall grade point average in all subjects accounts for 60%**, and the success achieved in the **state high school graduation exam or the state vocational high school graduation exam accounts for 40%**.

a.1. Calculation of points based on the overall grade point average

For the study programs where the selection will be **based solely on the grade point average from secondary education**, the scoring is carried out in the following way: all grades entered in the transcripts from all years are added up, the resulting sum is divided by the number of grades, and the average grade thus obtained is multiplied by 12. On this basis, a maximum of **60 points** can be obtained.

a.2. Calculation of points based on the overall grade point average achieved at the state high school graduation exam or the state vocational high school graduation exam

a.2.1.a. For candidates who took the state high school graduation exam in the academic years 2022/2023, 2023/2024, 2024/2025, and the state vocational/artistic high school exam in the academic year 2025/2026, the scoring of the success achieved in taking the state high school graduation exam or the state vocational/artistic high school diploma carries a maximum of **40 points** and is carried out in the following manner:

For the two external subjects:

- For candidates who, at the state high school graduation exam or the state vocational/artistic high school graduation exam, have taken an external subject that is **relevant** to the study program for which they are applying (Annex 1), the percentile rank of the candidate for the respective subject divided by 20 is added to the grade of each external subject, and then multiplied by 1.0. (e.g., $5 + 100/20 = (5 + 5)*1 = 10$ points)
- For candidates who, at the state high school graduation exam or the state vocational/artistic high school graduation exam, have taken an external subject that is not **relevant** to the study program for which they are applying, the percentile rank of the candidate for the respective subject divided by 33 is added to the grade of each external subject, and then multiplied by 1.0. (e.g., $5 + 100/33 = (5 + 3.03)*1 = 8.03$ points)

20 points can be obtained for the two external subjects on this basis.

For the two internal subjects:

- The grades from each of the internal subjects taken at the state high school graduation exam or the state vocational/artistic high school graduation exam that are **relevant** to the study program for which the candidate is applying are multiplied by a coefficient of 1.6.
- The grades from each of the internal subjects taken at the state high school graduation exam or the state vocational/artistic high school graduation exam that are **not relevant** to the study program for which the candidate is applying are multiplied by a coefficient of 1.2.

The results thus obtained are added together. On this basis, a maximum of **16 points** can be obtained.

For the project assignment:

The grade obtained on the project assignment is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8. On this basis, a maximum of **4 points** can be obtained.

a.2.1.b. For candidates who took the state high school graduation in the academic years 2021/2022 and 2020/2021, the scoring of the success achieved in taking the state high school graduation carries a maximum of **40 points** and is carried out as follows:

For the two external subjects:

- For candidates who took an external subject at the state high school graduation exam that is **relevant** for the study program they are applying for (Appendix 1), the candidate's percentile rank for the appropriate subject is added to the grade for each external subject, divided by 20, and then multiplied by 1.2.
- For candidates who took an external subject at the state high school graduation exam that is **not relevant** for the study program they are applying to, the points for that subject are multiplied by a factor of 0.9.

On this basis, a maximum of **24 points** can be obtained for the two external subjects.

For the two internal subjects:

- The grades from each of the internal subjects taken at the state high school graduation exam, which are **appropriate** for the study program for which the candidate is applying, are multiplied by a coefficient of 1.2.
- The grades from each of the internal subjects taken at the state high school graduation exam, which are **inappropriate** for the study program for which the candidate is applying, are multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8.

The results thus obtained are added together. On this basis, a maximum of **12 points** can be obtained for two relevant subjects, **10 points** for one relevant and one non relevant subject, and **8 points** for two non relevant subjects.

For the project assignment:

The grade obtained on the project assignment is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8. On this basis, a maximum of **4 points** can be obtained. be obtained.

a.2.2. For candidates who completed their secondary education in the academic year 2019/20 and did not take the high school graduation exam in accordance with the Decree Having the Force of Law for the Application of the Law on Secondary Education During a State of Emergency, in addition to the calculation of points under point 5.a.1, a maximum of 40 points is also calculated from the subjects that are relevant for the study program, as follows: the sum of the grades from each of the two subjects relevant for the study program (Annex 2) is divided by the number of grades (regardless of in how many years the subject was studied in secondary education), and the resulting average grade for each subject separately is multiplied by 4. On this basis, a maximum of 20 points can be obtained for one subject, i.e., a total of **40 points** for both subjects.

a.2.3. For candidates who took the state high school graduation exam in the period from the academic year 2013/2014 to the academic year 2018/2019, the scoring of the success achieved in taking the state high school graduation exam carries a maximum of **40 points** and is carried out in the following manner:

For the three external subjects:

- For candidates who, on the state high school graduation exam, have taken an external subject that is **relevant** to the study program for which they are applying, the percentile rank of the candidate (expressed as a percentage) for the respective subject divided by 20 is added to the grade of each external subject.
- For candidates who, on the state high school graduation exam, have taken an external subject that is **not relevant** to the study program for which they are applying, the points for that subject, obtained according to the above methodology, are multiplied by a factor of 0.5.
- On this basis, a maximum of **30 points** can be obtained for the three external subjects.

For an internal subject:

- The grade from the internal subject taken at the state high school graduation exam that is **relevant** to the study program for which the candidate is applying is multiplied by a coefficient of 1.2.

- The grade from the internal subject taken at the state high school graduation exam that is **not relevant** to the study program for which the candidate is applying is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8.

On this basis, a maximum of **6 points** can be obtained for a relevant internal subject, or **4 points** for a non-relevant internal subject.

For the project assignment:

The grade obtained on the project assignment is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8. On this basis, a maximum of **4 points** can be obtained. be obtained.

a.2.4. Candidates who took the state high school graduation exam from the 2007/08 school year to the 2012/2013 school year will have their score on the state high school graduation exam awarded a maximum of **40 points** and will be assessed as follows:

For the two external subjects:

- For candidates who have taken an external subject at the state high school graduation exam that is **relevant** for the study program they are applying for, the candidate's percentile rank for the appropriate subject divided by 20 is added to the grade for each external subject.
- For candidates who took an external subject at the state high school graduation exam that is **not relevant** for the study program they are applying for, the points for that subject are multiplied by a factor of 0.5.

On this basis, a maximum of **20 points** can be obtained for the two external subjects.

For the two internal subjects:

- The grades from each of the internal subjects taken at the state high school graduation exam, which are **relevant** for the study program for which the candidate is applying, are multiplied by a coefficient of 1.6.
- The grades from each of the internal subjects taken at the state high school graduation exam, which are **not relevant** for the study program for which the candidate is applying, are multiplied by a coefficient of 1.

The results thus obtained are added together. On this basis, a maximum of **16 points** can be obtained for two suitable items, **13 points** for one relevant and one not relevant subject, and **10 points** for two not relevant subjects.

For the project assignment:

The grade obtained on the project assignment is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8. On this basis, a maximum of **4 points** can be obtained. be obtained.

a.2.5. Candidates who completed secondary education before the 2007/2008 school year and did not take the state high school graduation exam, in addition to calculating the points from point 5.a.1, a maximum of 40 points for subjects that are relevant for the study program are also calculated, as follows: the sum of the grades from each of the two subjects relevant for the study program (Annex 2) is divided by the number of grades (regardless of how many years the subject was taken in secondary education) and the average grade obtained in this way, for each subject separately, is multiplied by 4. On this basis, a maximum of 20 points can be obtained for one subject, i.e. a total of **40 points** for both subjects.

b) In the study programs with specific characteristics (at the Faculty of Architecture, the Faculty of Dramatic Arts, the Faculty of Fine Arts and the Faculty of Music), the selection of candidates will be based on the grade point average from secondary education and an assessment of the knowledge and skills of the candidates. Candidates are ranked by adding the points obtained on both bases.

- At the Faculty of Architecture, candidates can earn a maximum of **100 points**, as follows: the grade point average from secondary education accounts for 60%, and success achieved on the aptitude test for studying architecture accounts for 40%.

The calculation of points from the grade point average from secondary education is carried out in the following way: the points from the grade point average from secondary education are obtained in accordance with points 5.a.1 and 5.a.2. of the Call for Applications. The total sum obtained is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.6. On this basis, a maximum of 60 points can be obtained.

- The calculation of points from the test of candidates' knowledge and skills is carried out in the following way: the evaluation of the success of the test for aptitude for studying architecture is carried out with a score from 0 to 40 points. The test has an eliminatory nature. Candidates who do not receive at least 15 points are not ranked. Candidates have the right to inspect the tests, exclusively in person, within 24 hours of the announcement of the preliminary results, and upon prior request submitted in writing to the Faculty archives. After this deadline, candidates do not have the right to inspect the tests.

- At the faculties of art (Faculty of Dramatic Arts, Faculty of Fine Arts and Faculty of Music), candidates can earn a maximum of **100 points**, as follows: the grade point average from secondary education accounts for 40%, and the success achieved at the the candidates' knowledge and skills test accounts for 60%.

The calculation of the the grade point average from secondary education is carried out in the following manner: the points from the grade point average in secondary education for candidates who have taken the state high school graduation exam or state vocational/artistic graduation exam is obtained in accordance with points 5.a.1 and 5.a.2. of the Call for Applications. The total sum obtained is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.4. On this basis, a maximum of **40 points** can be obtained. The calculation of the points for the test of candidates' knowledge and skills is carried out in the following manner: the evaluation of the success from the assessment of candidates' knowledge and skills is done by scoring from 0 to 60 points. The assesment has an eliminatory character. Candidates who do not receive at least 10 points are not ranked. The calculation of points from the knowledge and skills assesment of candidates at the Faculty of Music is carried out in accordance with the Guidelines for determining the subjects and examination programs for the assesment knowledge and skills for enrollment in the first cycle of study programs at the Faculty, as well as for the method of scoring knowledge and skills and the method of calculating points.

After the results of the knowledge and skills test are announced, candidates have the right to file an objection within 24 hours of the publication of the results. Candidates have the right to inspect the tests.

c) At the Faculty of Pedagogy and the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics (teaching study programs), pre-selection of candidates is carried out through an interview, which is not scored. Candidates are ranked according to points 5.a.1 and 5.a.2. of the Call for Applications.

III. Selection of Candidates

1. For the implementation of the Call for Application for enrollment, the Teaching-Scientific Council of the faculty establishes an Admissions Committee, while the Faculty of Architecture and the faculties in the field of arts also establish committees for the assessment of knowledge and skills.
2. For the purposes of monitoring the implementation of the Call for Application, the Rectorate establishes a University Admissions Committee. The University Admissions Committee monitors the implementation of the Call for Application at the faculties, ensures consistent compliance with the provisions of the Call for Application, and provides instructions and opinions during its implementation. The University Admissions Committee adopts an Instruction for the Implementation of the Call for Application.
3. The ranking of candidates is carried out by the Call for Applications committees of the individual faculties.
4. The Admissions Committee publishes a preliminary ranking list on the faculty's notice board with the points from secondary education (average grade point average), and the results from the assessment of knowledge and skills, for the study programs where such assessment is implemented.
 After the publication of the preliminary ranking list of candidates for enrollment, the candidate has the right to file an objection within 24 hours. Otherwise, they lose the right to object in the further procedure regarding the published results. The objection pertains only to technical errors - mistakes made during the calculation of points - and is submitted to the Admissions Committee of the faculty. The decision of the committee on the objection is final. Decisions on objections are published at the faculties.
 After the deadlines for submitting complaints and resolving them have expired, the Admissions Committee of the relevant faculty publishes a decision on student admission (final ranking list), on the basis of which student enrollment is carried out.
 The faculty simultaneously submits the decision of the admission committee (the final ranking list) to the University Rectorate.
5. Faculties that have unfilled places after the end of the first enrollment deadline shall carry out enrollment in a second or third enrollment deadline.
6. If, during the enrollment of candidates, any candidate who has passed the entrance exam and was ranked on the final ranking list in the first enrollment deadline does not submit the enrollment documents and does not enroll, then the Faculty Admission Committee shall re-rank, filling the vacated spots on the Ranking List by moving the subsequent candidates who have passed the entrance exam up the Ranking List according to their total number of points.

IV. Enrollment of Full-Time Students within the State Quota

1. Students within the state quota are enrolled with payment a study fee in the amount of 200 euros, in denars equivalent, according to the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of the Republic of Macedonia.
2. The payment of the fee shall, as a rule, be made in two equal installments, upon enrollment in the winter semester and the summer semester, respectively.
3. The fee referred to in paragraph 1 of this point shall be borne by the students who maintain their status as full-time students within the state quota, in accordance with the Statute of the Ss. Cyril and Methodius University (UKIM), throughout the entire duration of their studies.
4. If, during the first enrollment deadline, at the end of the list of admitted candidates there are multiple candidates with an equal number of points (up to a maximum of five candidates), the faculty shall enroll all such candidates. If, however, the number of such candidates exceeds 5, then the faculties shall rank these candidates according to additional criteria: relevance of the project assignment at the state high school graduation exam, awards won at national and international competitions, membership in sports teams representing the Republic of North Macedonia, obtained certificates for knowledge of foreign languages at a higher level, etc.
5. Members of the security forces and other categories of persons determined by the Law on the Special Rights of Members of the Security Forces of the Republic of North Macedonia and their Family Members, persons determined by the provision of Art. 23 of the same Law (Official Gazette of the Republic of North Macedonia No. 2/02, 17/03, 30/04 and 66/07 and Official Gazette of the Republic of North Macedonia No. 53/21), in the academic year 2026 /2027, shall enroll outside the state quota without paying study fees, under the enrollment conditions set out in this Call for Applications, and their number may amount to a maximum of 10% of the total number of students at the level of the study program. Candidates exercise the right from the previous paragraph upon application, with a document from the Ministry of Defense or the Ministry of Internal Affairs. Additional submission of a document for candidates enrolling in the first year shall not be taken into account.
6. The higher education institution shall not charge tuition participation fees for:
 - Aa person who, up the age of 18, had the status of a child without parents, up to a maximum of 26 years of age, provided they are unemployed (proven by a certificate from the competent center for social work);
 - Persons with disabilities, in accordance with the decree adopted by the Government (proven by the finding and opinion of the Functional Assessment Service at the Public Health Institution Health Center - Skopje) and with a decision of the Center for Social Work regarding the type and degree of disability);
 - A parent of a child up to 6 years of age, if unemployed (proven with an extract from the child's Birth Registry and a certificate of registered unemployment);
 - War invalids (proven with a decision of the Ministry of Labor and Social Policy - Directorate for Affairs of Veterans and War Invalids);
 - People raised in homes for abandoned children, if unemployed;
 - Other persons determined by the Government decree adopted upon the proposal of the National Council.

These candidates shall enroll outside the quota, up to a maximum of **10%** of the total number of full-time students at the respective faculty determined in the Call for Applications.

The funds for the participation of these persons shall be covered by the Budget of the Republic of North Macedonia.

V. Enrollment of Full-Time Students with Tuition Fees

1. At the faculties, candidates who meet the enrollment conditions but, due to limited quotas, cannot enroll in the category of students financed by the state, also enroll as full-time students. Ranking in this category of students is carried out with a prior statement submitted by the candidates that they agree to co-finance their studies throughout the entire duration of their studies.
2. Students enrolling in this category pay a tuition fee of **400 euros**, in denar equivalent, according to the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of the Republic of Macedonia on the day of payment, in at least two equal installments.
3. Students pay the fee from the previous paragraph of this item throughout their entire studies.
4. The faculty publishes a ranking list of candidates who meet the requirements for enrollment in this category.

The list of admitted candidates in this category is determined by the Admissions Committee based on the ranking list and the submitted statements of consent for enrollment in this category.

Upon enrollment, students with co-financing enter into an agreement with the faculty regarding the mutual rights and obligations in the implementation of the teaching-educational process.

VI. Enrollment of Part-Time Students

1. For certain study programs at the faculties, candidates who meet the enrollment conditions and are employed may enroll as part-time students, as well as candidates who, for justified reasons, are unable to enroll as full-time students.
2. Justified reasons from the previous paragraph include: a person with a disability who is unable to attend classes; a serious long-term illness that prevents regular attendance at classes for longer than one semester; a parent of a child during maternity leave.
3. Part-time students enroll under the same conditions and criteria as full-time students and are ranked on a separate ranking list.
4. Students enrolling in this category pay a tuition fee of **400 euros**, in denar equivalent, according to the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of the Republic of Macedonia on the day of payment, in at least two equal installments.
5. The fee from paragraph 2 of this item shall be borne by students throughout the entire duration of their studies.
6. When applying for enrollment as part-time students, candidates submit a notarized M1/M2 form, or a medical certificate for the reasons stated in point 1, paragraph 2 (issued by the Student Polyclinic of the Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje).

VII. Candidates with Secondary Education Completed Abroad

a) Foreign nationals

1. Foreign nationals enroll outside the enrollment quotas for Macedonian nationals.
 2. The tuition fee for foreign nationals in the 2026/2027 academic year is given in Chapter I of the Call for Applications.
 3. The selection of candidates is carried out according to the relevance of the previously completed secondary education in relation to the study program for which they are applying and according to the grade point average from secondary education.
- The selection of candidates applying for studies at the Faculty of Architecture and the faculties in the field of arts is carried out with an assessment of their knowledge and skills (II / 5.b).
4. Application and enrollment

Candidates referred to in Chapter VII - item a) apply at the Rectorate of Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje, within the deadlines set by the Call for Applications.

Candidates apply electronically to the following address: st.student@ukim.edu.mk.

Additionally, they should submit the original documents to the University Rectorate.

When applying, candidates are to submit:

- Enrollment Application (A1 Form);
- Original diploma of completed secondary education (certified with an apostille seal, i.e. a seal from the appropriate Ministry of Foreign Affairs for countries that are not members of the Hague Convention);
- Original transcripts for each completed year of secondary education;
- Original birth certificate; and
- Original certificate of citizenship.

Student enrollment is carried out at the faculties, during the third enrollment deadline.

Upon enrollment, candidates submit:

- Decision for nostrification of secondary education completion documents, issued by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of North Macedonia;
- Index (student record book), student ID card, and application forms;
- Three photos (two photos measuring 3.5x4.5 and one measuring 2x3);
- Evidence of payment of 750 denars for informational, IT, cultural and sports activities of students at Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje, with the designation **"IKSA at UKIM"**, _____ (indicate the faculty - holder of the study program), to the bank account 10000000063095, bank: National Bank of the Republic of North Macedonia, with the account of the budget user 1600103689 788 18, revenue code 723012, program 41.
- Evidence of paid tuition fees for the semester.

5. The university organizes instructions for learning the language in which the teaching of the chosen study program is conducted, in parallel with the regular classes.

- For foreign national candidates, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje organizes a one-year short professional study program: Macedonian Language for Foreigners, within the first cycle of studies, lasting two semesters.

Instruction is organized in the winter and summer semesters and is implemented according to a separate study program. During the course, the knowledge of the candidates - listeners is continuously checked.

Upon successful completion of the instruction and the acquisition of 60 ECTS, students receive a certificate of completion of the short professional study program issued by the Blaze Koneski Faculty of Philology.

- For foreign national candidates enrolled in English study programs, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje organizes a one-year short professional study program: English Language for Foreign Students, within the first cycle of studies, lasting two semesters.

The course is organized in the winter and summer semesters and is implemented according to a special study program.

During the course, the knowledge of the candidates - participants is continuously assessed.

After successfully completing the course and acquiring 60 ECTS, students receive a certificate of completion of a short professional study program issued by Blaze Koneski Faculty of Philology.

Candidates referred to in Chapter VII - item a-5 apply at the Student Affairs Office of the Blaze Koneski Faculty of Philology in Skopje.

b) Nationals of the Republic of Macedonia with complete secondary education completed abroad and with part of their secondary education completed abroad

1. Candidates whose parents are emigrants of the country and candidates who are nationals of the Republic of North Macedonia, who completed their entire secondary education abroad enroll outside the quota, with co-financing of their studies.

The selection of candidates referred to in point 1, at the Faculty of Architecture and the faculties in the field of arts, is carried out with an assessment of knowledge and skills (II / 5.b).

The tuition fee for this category of students amount to the denar equivalent of 400 euros per academic year (as for candidates from Chapter V).

Along with their application, candidates referred to in point 1 submit a notarized diploma for secondary education completed abroad.

These candidates enroll outside the quota, but at a maximum of up to 10% of the state quota.

2. Candidates who are nationals of the Republic of North Macedonia who have completed part of their secondary education abroad enroll under the same conditions and criteria as candidates who have completed their secondary education in the Republic of North Macedonia, with the addition that, in addition to other documents, they also submit nostrified certificates for the part of their secondary education completed abroad.

Candidates referred to in Chapter VII, point b. 1) apply at the Rectorate of Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje, and candidates from Chapter VII, point b. 2.) apply at the appropriate faculty.

VIII. Candidates with International Baccalaureate and Candidates from Private Secondary Schools in the Republic of North Macedonia

1. Candidates with International Baccalaureate enroll under the same conditions and criteria as candidates with completed secondary education in the Republic of North Macedonia. For these candidates, the points from the overall grade point average of secondary education are obtained in accordance with Chapter II, item 5.a.1 of this Call for Applications. The scoring of the success achieved on the International Baccalaureate is carried out as follows: each grade from the six external subjects taken on the International Baccalaureate is multiplied by a coefficient of 1.2. The points obtained in this way are added up. On this basis, a maximum of **36 points can be obtained. The grade obtained on the extended essay is multiplied by a coefficient of 0.8. On this basis, a maximum of 4 points** can be obtained. The overall success on the International Baccalaureate may yield a maximum of **40 points**.

2. Candidates who have completed secondary education in private secondary schools in the Republic of North Macedonia where a state high school graduation exam is taken enroll under the same conditions and criteria as candidates with completed secondary education in the Republic of North Macedonia in accordance with Chapter II, point 5 of this Call for Applications.

Candidates referred to in Chapter VIII apply at the appropriate faculty.

IX. Additional Quotas Determined by the Government of the Republic of North Macedonia

1. In order to ensure fair and adequate representation of students who are members of communities that are not in the majority in the Republic of North Macedonia, at the higher education institutions of Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje, in the academic year 2026/2027, additional students who are members of these communities will be enrolled, the number of which shall not exceed **10%** of the total number of students enrolling in the first year - first cycle of studies at the faculty level. In this regard, within this percentage, members of all communities shall be adequately represented, up to the percentage at which the relevant community is represented in the total population of the Republic of North Macedonia.

- At the higher education institutions of Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje, where there are study programs that are also offered at the State University of Tetovo and at Mother Teresa University of in Skopje, members of the Albanian community may only enroll within the regular quotas.

The percentage of students who are members of these communities, together in the state and additional quota, shall be up to the percentage of representation of the respective community in the total population of the Republic of North Macedonia.

 - 300 denars to the faculty's bank account, for study programs for which no assessment of knowledge and skills is conducted;
 - 500 denars to the faculty's bank account, for study programs for which an assessment of knowledge and skills is conducted in one subject;
 - 1,000 denars to the faculty's bank account, for study programs for which an assessment of knowledge and skills is conducted in multiple subjects at the Faculty of Music and the Faculty of Fine Arts, or 1,500 denars at the Faculty of Dramatic Arts.

In addition to the above, candidates applying for enrollment as part-time students shall attach the documents listed in Chapter VI, point 3.

Upon **enrollment**, admitted candidates submit:

4. Evidence of payment of costs related to specifics in the implementation of study programs for faculties where this is provided.

The fee referred to in the previous paragraph of this item is paid by all admitted candidates, in all categories of students (including students exempt from paying participation and co-financing on various grounds). Students pay this fee every academic year, upon enrollment in the winter semester.
