II. Eligibility of Applicants

- Candidates who meet the general requirement of having completed the first cycle of relevant or related studies, and meet other requirements of study programs for second cycle of studies at the respective faculty or scientific institute may enroll.
- Candidates who have completed the first cycle of relevant studies and meet other requirements stipulated by the Architecture Study Program (second-cycle academic studies – postgraduate studies) shall have the right to apply for enrollment in the **second cycle at the Faculty of Architecture**.
- **An interview with candidates shall be required for their enrollment in Conference Interpreting studies at the Blaže Koneski Faculty of Philology.**
Upon expiry of the deadline for applying, the candidates will be invited for an interview. A positive result from the interview is required for enrollment.
An invitation will be sent to candidates who meet the requirements for enrollment as per the study program, and who have submitted their complete documentation.

- III. Documents Required for Application and Enrollment

Prior to applying within the periods specified in the Competition, each candidate shall register at www.upisi.ukim.mk and fill out the electronic application in the iKnow system.

The number that the candidate automatically received from the electronic application system shall also be entered in the application form submitted when applying for enrollment.

Applications shall be filed with the Student Inquiry Service of the faculty selected.

When **applying** for admission to faculties, candidates shall submit the following documents:

- Signed University Application Form and Internal Application Form (generated by the iKnow system);
- Original document for completed first cycle of studies (diploma or certificate), and for candidates who graduated abroad - Decision recognizing completed education documents, issued by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of North Macedonia
- Short resume (CV);
- Certificate for active knowledge of a foreign language;
- Payment slip for the administrative fee in the amount of 50 denars (PP 50 form: Recipient's name: Treasury account – Skopje; Recipient's bank: NBRNM; Transaction account 100-0000000-630-95; Payment account 840-XXX-03161; Account 722313 00;
- 1000 denars to the giro account of the *Faculty for Dramatic Arts for enrollment in study programs which require knowledge and skill testing*;
- Recommendation letters from teaching or scientific workers (if any);
- List of professional or scientific papers and a copy thereof (if the candidates have any);
- Documents for any possible awards, acknowledgements or other documents.

Applicants shall receive an automatic confirmation that their email has been received and that the application has been duly submitted.

The Units shall publish on their bulletin boards the deadlines by which the candidates have to submit their original documents for application and enrollment.

When **enrolling**, the accepted candidates shall submit the following:

- Student's index (booklet) and application forms;
- Two photos (3.5 x 4.5);
- Payment slip regarding the costs specific to study program implementation at faculties where this is foreseen.

- At the Faculty of Architecture, the applications registration within the first period will take place on 14 and 15 September 2026, while enrollment will take place on 25 September 2026.

- At faculties/institutes with a number of study programs, in addition to their first choice of study program they are applying for, candidates are given the opportunity to choose one or more additional study programs, that is, to opt for the second, third, etc. study program if they fail to be ranked among the candidates accepted for their first study program selected.
